

TERN carries out Environmental Education and Awareness development activities at different sites in the country independently and together with collaborators and other interested groups. General awareness development topics help the target groups (Local communities, school children and public) to understand sustainable use and management of natural resources, Biodiversity Conservation, climate change, ecosystem benefits and the link between the natural resources and sustainable livelihoods, threats to biodiversity and migratory measures, participatory resource management and how to co-exist sustainably with nature etc. Specific programmes focus on groups that require special training such as the use of advance tools in wildlife management, taxonomy etc. The programme develops skills, knowledge, values, attitudes and change in behaviour, bringing up environmental responsible citizens who care and protect the environment.
